**CIRCULAR**

**Sub: Guidelines for Heads of Schools regarding Non-Plan Admission in Class XI for the Academic Session 2024-25.**

All the applicants residing in Delhi and seeking admission to class XI in Govt. Schools under Directorate of Education are informed that for the Academic Session 2024-25 process of online Registration is going to commence from 22-05-24. ***Students who have passed class X during Academic Session 2023-24 from Govt. / Govt. Aided Schools are not eligible to apply for registration. They shall approach their last attended school for further assistance if transfer is required to another Govt. school.***

**Academic Criteria for Non Plan Admission:-**

Students declared passed in the Secondary School Examination will be considered for admission in any stream of Class XI subject to the following eligibility criteria:-

<b>Humanities</b>	<p>A student must have been declared Pass at the Secondary School Examination by the CBSE or its equivalent board.</p> <p>For giving Economics as a subject, a student must have secured at least 45% in Aggregate.</p> <p>For giving Mathematics as a subject, a student must have secured at least 50% in Standard Mathematics/Basic Mathematics/ Mathematics.</p>			

**All Heads of Govt. Schools are hereby informed that relaxation of 5% marks in any one of the three subjects mentioned above for admission in particular stream is to be given in respect of candidates belonging to the categories SC/ST/ Minorities/OBC(Non-Creamy Layer)/Kashmiri Migrants & those students having I/II/III position in National Games.**

**For Specially Abled Students, relaxation of 5% marks in all subjects mentioned for admission in particular stream is to be given.**

Students who have passed their Secondary Examination (Class X) directly from NIOS with 55% marks or above in aggregate of 5 main subjects are eligible for admission in Humanities without Skill Subjects & with 50 % marks or above in aggregate of 5 main subjects are eligible for admission in Humanities with Skill Subjects.

Students who have passed class X from other boards having criteria of passing below 33% of the maximum marks, may not be able to submit application online. In such cases, applicant may apply for admission manually in any school nearer to his/her residence till 21-08-24. In such cases concerned HoS will forward the file with all relevant documents to the concerned DDE (Zone) for allotment of school. The Student ID of these students will be generated as explained in point (xii) of Procedure for Non Plan Admission.

## Procedure for Non Plan Admission:-

- i). Parents/candidates residing in Delhi and seeking admission of their ward/wards in Govt. Schools under Directorate of Education can apply for online registration through link available at [www.edudel.nic.in](http://www.edudel.nic.in) at **“Govt. School Admissions”** during any one of the 3 (three) cycles as per above mentioned schedule.
- ii). Candidate will be provided a Login ID & Password during registration.
- iii). Candidates may keep the online generated printout of the filled Registration Form or note the online generated registration number for future reference. The form can also be reprinted after login at the link provided at homepage. The registration number will also be forwarded to the applicant through SMS at the registered mobile number.
- iv). If required, the candidate can delete the above Registration Form online at the departmental website i.e. [www.edudel.nic.in](http://www.edudel.nic.in) and resubmit a fresh application before last date of registration of that particular cycle.
- v). Once a candidate is registered online for admission in class XI, his/her name will be reflected at the level of respective DDE (Zone).
- vi). Procedure for allotment of schools to registered candidates:
  - a. Schools will be allotted to the candidates by the Zonal Level Admission Committee.
  - b. DDE (Zone) may constitute a Zonal Level Admission Committee under his/her chairpersonship consisting of following members:-
    - i. 3-4 HoSs of the concerned Zone.
    - ii. 2 SMC parent members nominated by concerned DDE (Zone).
  - c. Committee will allot school to those applicants who are fulfilling the required eligibility criteria. The marks details filled by candidates in the Registration Form and Mark Statements of relevant classes uploaded by the candidates will also be made available to them to enable them to check correctness of information given by the applicant in the Registration Form. While allocating the school to applicant Nearest School / Residential Address mentioned in the Registration Form may be given due consideration, subject to availability of stream/subjects combination and vacancy in that school or schools in the nearby area.
  - d. Order of preference to be followed for allotment of schools to applicants is as under:
    - i. Applicants having passed previous class from Recognised Schools situated in Delhi during 2023-24.
    - ii. Applicants having passed previous class from Recognised Schools of other states during 2023-24.
    - iii. All other eligible applicants.

- e. If no seat is available in the zone for desired stream/combination of subjects, the concerned DDE (Zone) may consult DDEs of the nearby Zones/Districts for allotment of schools to the applicants.
  - f. Process of allotment of schools to the applicants must be completed as per above mentioned schedule of the concerned cycle as the link will be closed thereafter.
- vii). The link for online allotment of schools at the level of Zone is available in the student module at

**Student Login --> Non Plan Admissions --> Allotment of Schools for Non-Plan Admissions for XI.**

- viii). Once a school is allotted by the Zonal Level Admission Committee, name of the applicant will be reflected for admission in the school allotted to him/her. The link for the online admission is available to allotted school at the link:-

**Student Login - -> Non Plan Admissions - - > Admission**

- ix). Applicants can also check the status of his/her application on or after date of display of allotted schools to registered applicants of the concerned cycle at the link for Non Plan Admission at the homepage of the department. Admission related information including school allotted will also be forwarded to the registered mobile number of the applicants.
- x). After allotment of the school, candidate should approach to the allotted school with all the required documents for completion of the admission process. Admission to students selected through online mode will be confirmed only after the physical verification of requisite documents by the Heads of the concerned Govt. Schools.
- xi). Heads of schools will ensure that applicant fulfils the age criteria as per circular no. DE.23.(363)/Sch. Br./2016/1553 dated 19.09.2016. Age relaxation up to one year may also be provided by the concerned Heads of Schools to applicants who have passed class X directly from NIOS and having no gap year.

Moreover, relaxation in upper and lower age up to six months may be granted by the Heads of Schools to applicants who have passed class X and having a gap year. Before admission of the applicant, HoS will also verify the other eligibility criteria for admission to that particular class.

Further, the regular students who have passed previous class during 2023-24 from any Recognised Unaided Schools of Directorate of Education or Local bodies of Delhi and having a valid SLC & Mark Sheet will be exempted from applicability of age appropriate criteria.

*Further to this, Director of Education at his discretion may provide relaxation in upper age to any deserving student (not covered under existing provisions) to remove the hardship on the grounds such as disruption of studies due to death of either of the parents, prolonged illness of either of the parents/child or any trauma*

faced by the student. In such cases, parents of the students are required to submit an application on the attached format to the Head of the school where the admission is sought along with supporting documents related to the grounds under which relief has been sought. **Head of that school, after recording his/her comments regarding suitability for age relaxation in the space provided in the Application Form, will forward the case to the concerned DDE (Zone) along with all the relevant documents including application of the candidate. If the case is found fit for age relaxation by the DDE (Zone), then after recording his clear recommendation in the space provided in the Application Form, DDE (Zone) will forward it to the School Branch through concerned district for the approval of Director of Education.**

**Heads of the Schools are hereby directed to counsel/guide students, whose application is not found fit for age relaxation, to get admission in Patrachar Vidyalaya/NIOS.**

- xii). If for admission, any applicant fails to register himself/herself during any of the three cycles, he/she may apply for admission manually in any school nearer to his/her residence till 21-08-24. The concerned HoS will forward his/her application to the concerned DDE (Zone) latest by 22-08-24 after verification of the relevant documents and checking the eligibility of the candidate along with the format given below:-

display the consolidated allotment list by 24-08-24 at prominent place in Zonal office. The DDE (Zone) will also forward the list of the allotted candidates to Heads of all the concerned schools. The format of the consolidated allotment list is as under:

The Heads of the concerned schools will also display the above list at prominent places of the school. HoS will also contact the parents of the allotted candidates and provisionally admit the candidates after verification of the relevant documents, till 31-08-24. Heads of the allotted schools will also depute a person to contact office of the concerned DDE (Distt.) for temporary Student ID generation along with copy of the consolidated allotment list forwarded by DDE (Zone) and the duly filled proforma given below by 04-09-24.

**For all the admission cases forwarded by Child Welfare Committee and DCPCR,** all the Heads of Govt. Schools under Directorate of Education are directed to follow the guidelines as under:

- For all such cases that are received before last date of registration of candidates, Heads of the schools are directed to call the candidate and register the student online for allotment of school.
- While, for cases received after last date of registration, the concerned HoS will forward his/her application to the concerned DDE (Zone) after verification of the relevant documents and checking the eligibility of the candidate.

The concerned DDE (Zone) will allot the schools to such candidates (offline) and display the consolidated allotment list at prominent place in Zonal office. The DDE (Zone) will also forward the list of the allotted candidates to Heads of all the concerned schools.

The various formats for this process will be same as mentioned above.

- xiii). Additional age relaxation is to be provided to divyang children, as per Circular No. F.265/DDE(IEDSS)/Admn.Cell/2017-18/458-470 dated 13/05/2022. HoS are to pay special attention that no child, who has applied for admission, remains out of school, specially Divyang children.
- xiv). Zonal Level Admission Committee will take care of all the aspects like distance from residence, availability of infrastructure/ vacancies in school, while allocating the school to the applicants.
- xv). The following documents are required to be produced by the parent/guardian at the time of admission:-
  - a) Proof of Date of Birth (any one of the following):
    - Countersigned SLC of a last attended recognized school as per Rule No. 139 of DSEAR, 1973 (if applicant has passed class X from recognised school).
    - Certificate of passing Class X / Migration certificate issued by the concerned Board (if applicant has passed class X directly from any recognised Board).
  - b) Mark Sheet of the previous class passed.
  - c) One passport size photograph of the child.
  - d) Anyone of the following documents as **Residence Proof of Delhi:-**
    - Ration Card issued in the name of parents having name of the child.
    - Domicile certificate of the child or any of the parents.

- Voter I card of any of the parents or the child.
- Electricity bill/MTNL telephone bill/Water bill.
- Bank Passbook in the name of child or any of the parents.
- Aadhaar number of the child or any of the parents.
- Passport in the name of child or any of the parents.

e) Certificate of Caste (in case of SC/ST/ OBC).

f) Certificate of disability (in case of Divyang Student).

xvi).DDE(Distt.) will ensure that:

- Help Desk to address admission related queries is set up at School/Zonal/Distt. Level.
- During the period of online registration, Help Desk consisting of senior teachers & SMC Members to address admission related queries/grievances is made available to the applicants as per schedule given below:
  - ✓ Morning and General Shift Schools : From 09:00 AM to 12:00 Noon
  - ✓ Evening Shift Schools : From 01:30 PM to 04:30 PM
- If any parent requires support in filling the online registration form, the desk will also assist the parents in filling and submitting online form.
- The Zonal Level Admission Committee should have the information about the tentative vacant seats, availability of combination of subjects and available infrastructure in every school of the zone before the Zonal Level Committee meeting.
- The schools with already very high student-classroom ratio may be excluded for non plan admission.

xvii). For any cycle, if a candidate reports to the Head of the allotted school for submission/verification of documents after last date of admission of the cycle, the concerned DDE (Zone) will be competent to condone the delay for admission till last date of admission i.e. 31-08-24. Therefore, Heads of the allotted schools may guide such students/parents to contact concerned DDE (Zone) office for condonation of delay for admission and ensure their admission till 31-08-24.

xviii). All the issues related to admissions and transfer of students will also be addressed in the Zonal and District Redressal Committee on the basis of genuineness & merit of the cases. The Redressal Committee will consist of following members:

- Two HoSs of the schools of the Zone/Distt..
- Two SMC parent members nominated by DDE (Zone/Distt.) respectively.

xix). All the Heads of Govt. Schools under Directorate of Education are to ensure that parents seeking admission of their wards are provided all the basic amenities like a room with proper seating arrangement with sufficient lighting & fans in working condition and clean drinking water. All the parents should be dealt with due politeness.

**CIRCULAR**

**Sub: Age Criteria for Non-Plan Admissions in Govt. Schools.**

Section 4 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 says, "Where a child above six years of age has not been admitted to any school or though admitted, could not complete his or her elementary education, then, he or she shall be admitted in a class appropriate to his or her age". The concept of age appropriateness prescribed by the law up to the completion of elementary education cannot be ignored in subsequent classes as it is required from peer learning and pedagogical point of view as well. Therefore, building upon the "age-class" relation established under the RTE Act, the Directorate of Education has continued with the prescribed age in natural progression for subsequent classes as well. Further, the Directorate also recognizes the fact that the stipulation of age cannot be in a straight jacket form. Hence, a relaxation of 6 months in terms of under and over age is also allowed.

In supersession to circulars No. DE.23(363)/Sch.Br./2014/452 dated 04.04.2014, DE.23(363)/Sch.Br./2016/683 dated 29.04.2016, DE.23(363)/Sch.Br./2016/1170 dated 13.07.2016 and DE.23(363)/Sch.Br./2016/1246 dated 01.08.2016 regarding Appropriate Age Criteria for Admission in Govt. Schools under Directorate of Education, all the Heads of Govt. Schools under Directorate of Education are hereby informed that the following criteria is to be followed for **Non Plan Admission** in Govt. Schools:

The age criteria for class KG to XII will be as mentioned below:-

Class	Appropriate Age as on 31 <sup>st</sup> March of the year
KG	The age of child should be 4+ but less than 5 years
I	The age of child should be 5+ but less than 6 years
II	The age of child should be 6+ but less than 7 years
III	The age of child should be 7+ but less than 8 years
IV	The age of child should be 8+ but less than 9 years
V	The age of child should be 9+ but less than 10 years
VI	The age of child should be 10+ but less than 12 years
VII	The age of child should be 11+ but less than 13 years
VIII	The age of child should be 12+ but less than 14 years
IX	The age of child should be 13+ but less than 15 years
X	The age of child should be 14+ but less than 16 years
XI	The age of child should be 15+ but less than 17 years
XII	The age of child should be 16+ but less than 18 years

- In addition to the above Table, further age relaxation is being granted at the level of Heads of Schools in the maximum as well as minimum age for 1 month for classes KG to V level as on 31<sup>st</sup> March of the year.
- Simultaneously, age relaxation is also being granted at the level of Heads of Schools in maximum as well as minimum age for 6 months as on 31<sup>st</sup> March of the year to all students seeking admission from class VI to X and XII in all the Govt. Schools under Directorate of Education.

- However, for class XI in addition to the above table, relaxation shall be granted in **maximum and minimum age for one year as on 31<sup>st</sup> March of the year** to those students seeking admission in class XI in the Govt. Schools under Directorate of Education, who have passed class X from CBSE or equivalent Board and there is no gap year.

**Illustration:**

A student who has completed 14 years of age on 31<sup>st</sup> March of the year and has passed Class X from CBSE or an equivalent Board may be granted admission in Class XI after allowing 1 year age relaxation in the minimum age criteria.

A student who is above 17 years of age but has not completed 18 years of age on 1<sup>st</sup> April of the year and has passed Class X from CBSE or an equivalent Board may be granted admission in Class XI after allowing 1 year age relaxation in the maximum age criteria.

- The above age criteria is not applicable to **Plan Admissions** and the existing students of Government Schools.
- The child who is below 14 years of age and have an SLC of a class lower than his age appropriate class may be enrolled in Special Training Centres (STC) and then brought to his age appropriate class. This provision is intended to mainstream all out of school children, including those who due to extreme learning deficiencies cannot be admitted to age appropriate classes.
- The Directorate of Education is going to introduce class IX in Patrachar Vidyalaya from next academic session i.e. 2017-18 for students who do not meet the appropriate age criteria. In case of a student who is at least 13 years old as on 31<sup>st</sup> March of the year when seeking admission, there will be no upper age bar and neither the School leaving certificate nor class VIII pass certificate is required for admission.
- Patrachar Vidyalaya is already functional for classes X to XII. The child should be at least 14 years of age as on 31<sup>st</sup> March of the year of seeking admission in Class X. Here again, there is no upper age bar and no requirement for school leaving certificate nor class VIII pass certificate.

**ORDER**

Directorate of Education (DoE) is committed to provide Inclusive Education and need based educational supports to Children with Disabilities (CwDs)/Children with Special Needs (CWSN) in its schools & recognizes the importance of creating enabling mechanisms for providing same opportunities of obtaining quality education as any other child studying in schools of Delhi.

In supervision of all previous orders, the revised instructions to enable CwDs/CWSN in getting admission as provided in RTE Act & RPWD Act 2016 are given as under:

1. Head of Schools of all school managements shall ensure that any child is not denied admission in a school on the ground of disability or severity of disability.
2. If a child seeking admission in a Govt./Govt. Aided school, lacks requisite documents, the HoS shall admit the child provisionally and provide time duration of maximum 03 (three) months for the child/parent to submit the said document/s after obtaining an undertaking.
3. Heads of schools are directed to ensure that CwDs/CWSN is not denied admission in schools only because of their age. Age relaxation given by HoS for admission of CwDs/CWSN shall be 04 years in upper age from class Nursery to Class XII in addition to the relaxation given by School Branch vide order No.DE.23(363)/Sch.Br./2016/1553 dated 19.09.2016. Even after getting the age relaxation, if the child is over age and s/he requests for additional relaxation with regard to admission, then the DDE (District) as a Nodal officer shall forward such case to IEB (HQ).
4. In all Govt./Govt. Aided schools, if a situation arises wherein the strength of students in a pre-primary/primary class reaches the maximum capacity in a particular section & a CwD/CWSN wishes to take admission, then the HoS shall submit the proposal to concerned DDE (District) for obtaining permission to allow admission for 02 CwDs/CWSN and same shall be considered by DDE (District) at their own level for 02 CwDs per section in a class at entry level as well as at higher classes in a academic year by ensuring appropriate infrastructure and facilities. If any admission case requires CBSE involvement, then the concerned HoS shall pursue CBSE but admission shall not be denied on the ground of disability or severity of disability.
5. An out-of-school child with disability who is identified under Home Based Education programme from time to time (as provided in RTE Amendment Act 2012) and who is otherwise eligible for all relaxations regarding admission shall not be denied admission in any Govt. & Govt. Aided school of their choice.
6. Heads of Schools shall not deny admission to CwDs/CWSN just on the ground that school doesn't have services of Special Educator and other facilities as provided in RTE Act & RPwD Act 2016.
7. For getting admission in Govt. & Govt. Aided schools, parents/guardians of CwDs/CWSN shall apply through online/offline mode only as per Departmental



guidelines for admitting their ward. If a parent/guardian of CwD/CWSN is unable to apply for admission within prescribed time period through online/offline mode, even then the Child with disability shall not be denied admission. HoS shall process their admission application and forward it to DDE (Districts) and the latter shall allow admission at their own level in the line of above-said instructions.

In this regard, all HoSs are hereby directed to comply with the above-said instructions in true letter and spirit failing which strict disciplinary action will be taken against them in accordance with the provisions of Section 89 of the RPWD Act, 2016.

Further, DDE (Districts) being Nodal Officers to deal with all matters related to admission of children with disabilities, shall ensure proper implementation of above instructions and allow relaxations as provided in above paras at their own level & monitor the same during their regular visits of schools for effective Inclusive Education of CwDs, in pursuance of the directions of Sections 16 (i) & 31 (1) of the RPwD, Act 2016.


